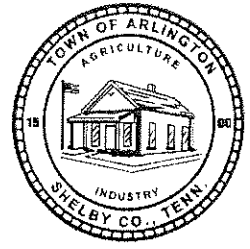

Mayor Wissman called the meeting to order and advised that a quorum was established.

II. Approval of the minutes from June 5, 2017.

Motion: Alderman McKee made a motion to approve the Beer Board minutes from June 5, 2017.
Alderman Brooks seconded the motion.

Vote on Main Motion: The motion carried unanimously.

III. Old Business.

There was no old business brought forward.

IV. New Business.

A. Application for ON Premise Beer Permit for Olympic Steak and Pizza, LLC located at 5183 Airline Road, Arlington, Tennessee 38002.

Mayor Wissman recognized Gerald Lawson, Town Attorney. Mr. Lawson stated that this was an application for the ON Premise Beer Permit for the new Olympic Steak and Pizza,

LLC. Application has been made and background checks have been approved. He stated that staff recommends approval.

Mayor Wissman called for a motion.

Main Motion: Alderman Pardue made a motion to approve the application for ON Premise Beer Permit for Olympic Steak and Pizza, LLC. Alderman Harmon seconded the motion.

Mayor Wissman called for a motion to suspend the Beer Board Meeting and open a public hearing.

Jeff Land, of 435 South Prescott Street, Memphis, Tennessee, stood to speak. He introduced himself as an attorney from Memphis, Tennessee. He represents the Sinis Family, who currently own three existing Olympic Steak and Pizza locations, in Atoka, Oakland, and Millington, Tennessee. This will be their fourth location, and they look forward to coming to Arlington and serving the community. He offered to answer any questions. He added that the anticipated opening for the restaurant is mid-September.

Mayor Wissman asked if anyone else wished to speak on the public hearing. Hearing no response, Mayor Wissman called for a motion to close the public hearing and resume the Beer Board meeting.

Motion: Vice Mayor McKee made a motion to close the public hearing and resume the Beer Board meeting. Alderman Brooks seconded the motion.

Vice Mayor McKee stated that they need to be aware of the Responsible Vendors Act, and get with Town staff with any questions, as well as be aware policies in place regarding violations. 
Vote on Main Motion: The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Wissman called for a motion to adjourn.


Main Motion: Alderman Brooks made a motion to adjourn. Alderman Harmon seconded the motion.
